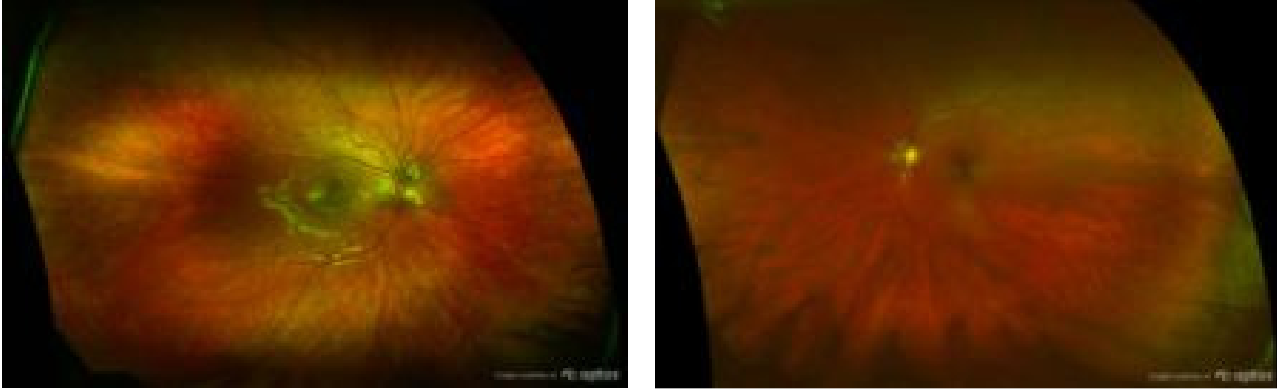


Optomap

Dr. Grimes & Dr. Yates recommend an Optomap retinal image annually for all patients 18 years of age or older. Baseline images are recommended for patients younger than 18 years old.



The Optomap, taken annually, gives us images of the inside of your eyes much like a dentist x-raying your mouth. The retinal images document the internal health of the eyes and allows for accurate yearly comparisons. This enables the doctor to detect early eye health changes so that timely treatment may be instituted to **preserve your sight**.

The Optomap is the only technology that **images the separate layers of the eye**, showing your doctor exactly where the problem lies.

Your vision insurance is defined as a minimal or basic examination. In order to provide **preventive** eye health evaluations and **preserve** your sight by **early detections** of systemic (body) diseases, such as diabetes, hypertension, and/or other eye diseases such as macular degeneration or glaucoma.
